

Naviance User Group Pre-Conference

Naviance Mentors will lead this hands-on mentoring session for any Minnesota counselor using Naviance. This session is appropriate for both newcomers and experienced Naviance users. There will be some brief presentations and discussion of Naviance “hot topics” which will be followed by time to implement new ideas on your own Naviance site and to gather information from mentors about how they are using Naviance to support and enhance their work with students and families in the college planning and application process.

This pre-conference session is part of a year-long program sponsored by a MACAC committee that provides professional development events and mentoring support for counselors using Naviance in high school and middle school. The project is funded by a Federal College Access Challenge Grant award to each state, and Minnesota's OHE uses part of the funding to support counselors with Naviance, and to support professional development.

The Naviance session is a great opportunity to gather counselors to work in a "hands on" setting to expand their use of Naviance, share ideas, and learn from colleagues. Attendees need to bring their own laptops in order to fully participate.

The Grant funding provides up to \$150 in expense reimbursement for each person attending the session. Attendees can submit mileage, registration, and/or lodging expenses up to this amount. Please bring receipts with you to the session where you will receive a reimbursement form.
